Handling of building materials for intermodal logistics centre in Malmö Industrial Park

CMP has handled cargo consisting of 840.29 m³ of timber beams, which will be used in the construction of the Dutch company Westerman Multimodal Logistics' new intermodal logistics centre. The logistics centre in Malmö Industrial Park, an expansive industrial area offering a perfect location for growth with attractive industrial land in Norra hamnen in Malmö, is expected to be completed by late summer.

The Belgian company MG Real Estate is acting as construction developer, and

is building and developing the logistics centre on behalf of Westerman Multimodal Logistics.

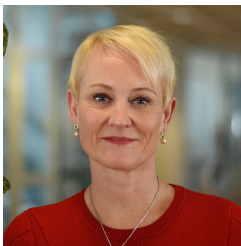
