For CMP, the absolute top priority is to find solutions that mean our customers will be affected as little as possible by the conflict. We are fully committed to trying to resolve the situation that has arisen in the best way possible and in close dialogue with the customers concerned. CMP plans to continue its operations to a large extent.
