Workplace accident at the container terminal in Copenhagen

CMP can confirm that a workplace accident occurred on Friday, October 4, at the container terminal in Copenhagen. An employee was seriously injured. Despite extensive treatment at the hospital, the employee passed away on Sunday evening, due to severe injuries.

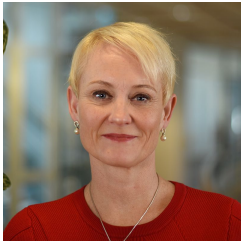
Since the accident, employees have been offered crisis support in various forms.

The work accident occurred when two so-called straddle carriers collided with each other. An official investigation has been initiated and CMP has no intention to comment further on the matter at this time.
